<b>Task 1</b> What would you like to learn about relating to our theme of 'If you go down to the woods today...'? Please complete the ideas card and return to school as soon as possible.	<b>Task 4</b> Animals that live in the forest often move silently. Can you swoop and fly silently like an owl? Are you able to run or hop silently like a deer or rabbit. Ask your family to close their eyes and listen.	<b>Task 7</b> Can you find out two facts about a woodland animal? You could record a video of these or ask your family to help you write these.
<b>Task 2</b> Can you recognise numbers to 5? To 10? Practise spotting numbers in lots of different places.	<b>Task 5</b> What is your favourite bedtime story? Send us a picture and tell us why. We will be doing something special with bedtime stories this term!	<b>Task 8</b> Birds also live in gardens, towns and cities. Can you make a bird feeder for all the birds that may visit your garden or window.
<b>Task 3</b> Can you find an interesting stick? What can you pretend your stick is? Maybe it could be a magic wand, wriggly snake or a pirate's telescope – how many ideas can you come up with? Bring your stick into school.	<b>Task 6</b> Go for a walk with your family and collect fallen leaves, sticks, acorns and pebbles. Can you make land art with your finds? It could be a face, pattern or a familiar object.	<b>Task 9</b> Take part in the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch between 26 <sup>th</sup> and 28 <sup>th</sup> January 2024.
