<p><b>Task 1</b> What would you like to learn as part of our new topic 'Let's Grow!'? Ask your family to write down your ideas and questions onto the card and bring it back into school.</p>	<p><b>Task 4</b> Take a walk around your local area – what can you find growing? What is your favourite thing that you found?</p>	<p><b>Task 7</b> Try making a model of a flower. You could use playdough, paper or card, construction toys, empty cardboard tubes and boxes or plastic tubs and pots. Think about how to make the stem, petals and leaves. You can bring your models into school – we would love to see them!</p>
<p><b>Task 2</b> Can you play a game using our tricky words?  <b>I, go, was, to, no, go, into, be, we, me, he, she, you, they, all, are, my, her</b>  Remember, you should practise reading your tricky words at least four times a week!</p>	<p><b>Task 5</b> Draw a picture of that you think would be at the top of Jasper's beanstalk. Write some short sentences to describe what you think you might see.</p>	<p><b>Task 8</b> How tall are the people in your house? Find something to measure them with – you could use boxes, blocks, steps etc. Measure the height of your family members, then talk about the size difference – who is the tallest? How tall are they?</p>
<p><b>Task 3</b> Read your school reading book at least four times a week! Ask your family to write in your reading diary when you have read.</p>	<p><b>Task 6</b> Try growing some plants, flowers, fruit or vegetables at home. Remember to give your seeds some water and put them somewhere sunny. Cress seeds grow very quickly in a yoghurt pot with cotton wool!</p>	<p><b>Task 9</b> We will be sharing the book 'Jasper's Beanstalk'. Jasper keeps a diary of what he did each day. Keep a diary just like Jasper – it could be about anything. What toys did you play with? What did you eat for breakfast?</p>
