Create your own fact file about one of them.</p>  <p>Find out and write down instructions for how to play the Maya ball game Pok-A-Tok.</p> <p>Write down 10 facts about the pyramid of El Castillo at Chichen Itza.</p> 	<p>Research the Maya number system. Can you spot a pattern? Write the first 100 numbers and then create 5 number calculations using the Maya number system.</p> <p>The Maya thrived in a rainforest environment. Collect a variety of twigs and leaves to create your own rainforest collage.</p> <p>Tikal City was one of the most powerful and influential Maya cities. Find out 10 interesting facts about it and write on your homework book.</p>	<p>Research Maya recipes and have a go at recreating one. Make sure an adult helps you in the kitchen.</p> <p>Write down 5 questions you would like to research about the Maya. Use the internet and books to present your research in an interesting way e.g. powerpoint, poster, fact sheet.</p> <p>The Maya loved their art work and, in particular, repeating patterns.
