<p><u>Maths</u> Timestables Visit https://www.timestables.co.uk/multiplication-tables-check/ and have a go at 25 question challenge!</p> 	<p><u>Roman Recipes</u> Research what Romans used to eat and write a recipe for a Roman dish, such as honey cakes or Roman-style bread. Include ingredients, cooking instructions, and a small drawing of what it would look like.</p>	<p><u>Roman Inventions Poster</u> Research some of the inventions or ideas that the Romans brought to Britain, such as aqueducts, roads, and underfloor heating. Make a poster showing three Roman inventions with illustrations and captions explaining each one.</p>
<p><u>Spelling</u> Pick 15 of the 100 Year 4 spellings and write a story using all the words!</p> 	<p><u>Aqueducts</u> Find out how Romans moved water using aqueducts. Draw a design for a Roman aqueduct, detailing how it works.</p> 	<p><u>Roman Gods and Goddesses Fact File</u> Create a fact file on three Roman gods or goddesses. Include their names, symbols, what they were known for, and one interesting story about each of them. Illustrate each god or goddess with a small picture.</p> 
<p><u>Reading</u> Read 5 times in one week! Don't forget to write it in your reading diary.</p> 	<p><u>Diary Entry of a Roman Child</u> Write a diary entry from the perspective of a Roman child in Britain. Describe a day in their life, mentioning things like school, games, clothing, and family activities.</p>	<p><u>Design Your Own Roman Mosaic Pattern</u> Using any materials you choose, design a simple Roman mosaic pattern. Choose a theme (like animals, plants, or a geometric design). Aim to use at least three colours in your design.</p>
