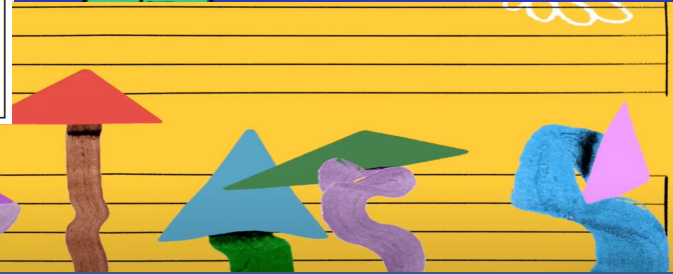
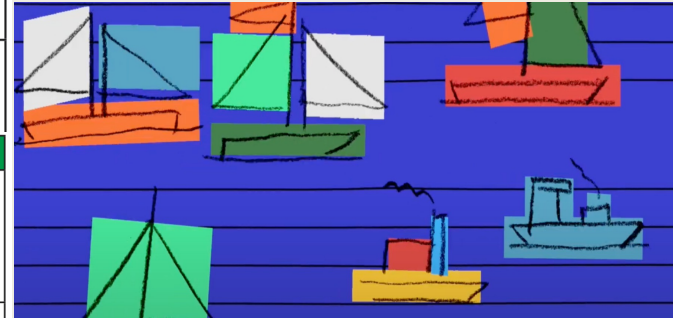


We will take part in the National Opera's programme. The children will choose their own colours and compose a piece of music to match the unfinished piece called Red, Blue, Yellow.





# NPA Knowledge Organiser: Year 4 Music - AUTUMN



We will explore the different stages required in creating a piece of music and write our own libretto, create images and drawings to match different sounds and look at which notes blend together to create soft sounds and which can make more dramatic noises. We will then put this all together into one final piece to present to the orchestra!



## Key Vocabulary

<b>scale</b>	A set of notes ordered in step by their pitch.
<b>score</b>	The written down version of a piece of music.
<b>octave</b>	A distance between two notes of the same letter name. 
<b>time signature</b>	Two numbers that sit on top of each other at the start of a section of music. They show how many beats are in a bar. 

## Musical Features

Sections of music can have different types of sound, such as:	
<b>staccato</b>	When the notes sound short and spiky.
<b>legato</b>	When the music sounds smooth and flowing.
<b>Singing</b>	
<b>crescendo</b>	When a composer wants music to get louder, they might use a symbol like this. 
<b>decrescendo</b>	When a composer wants music to get quieter, they might use a symbol like this. Another name for this symbol is diminuendo.
